DRAFT Committee Goals

1

Develop guidelines for the Los Feliz Neighborhood Council on the issues concerning the protection and provision of affordable housing in Los Feliz.

2

Provide a forum for Los Feliz stakeholders to learn about policies affecting housing and affordability in Los Angeles.

3

Engage Los Feliz stakeholders in a collaborative process that meaningfully reflects the diversity of thought on housing affordability in the neighborhood.

Phasing & Approach

Goal Setting

- Collaboratively set broad goals and vision of guidelines

Research & Learning

- Subcommittees form & research topics of interest
- Co-chairs invite a group of housing experts to present to Committee

Policy roundtables

- Sub-committees educate other committees on findings

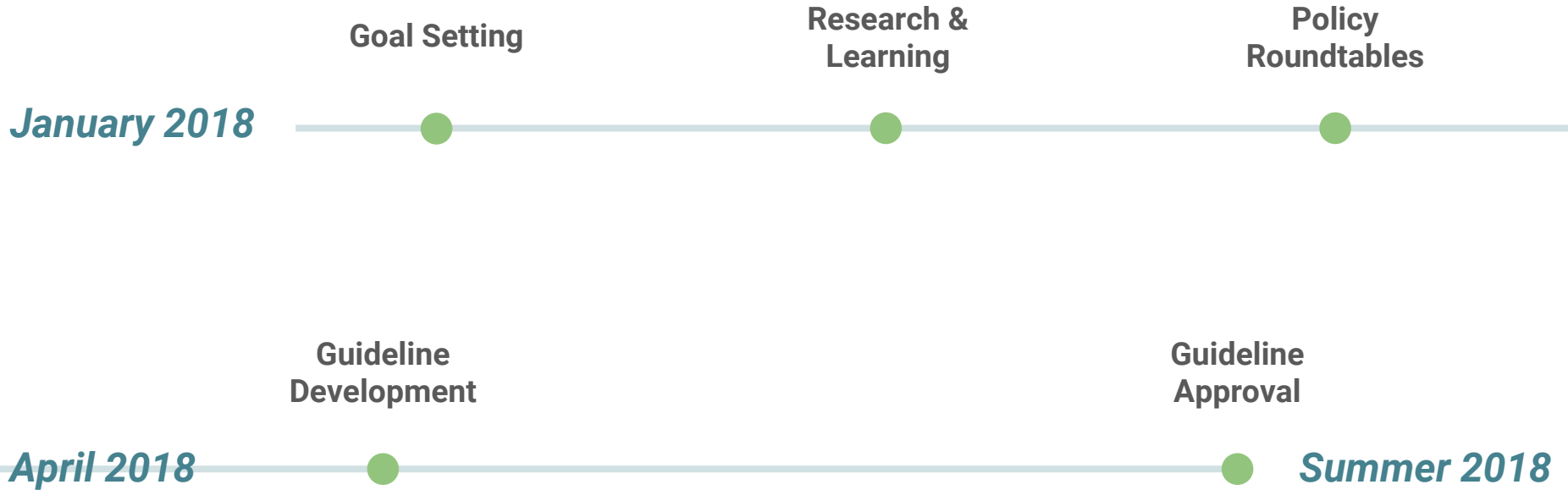
Guideline Development

- Collaboratively develop guidelines based on sub-committee findings and discussion

Guideline Approval

- Committee determines priority and “ice box” list of guidelines
- Co-chairs present findings to LFNC Governing Board

Timeline



Progress to date

- 22 letters of interest to join committee
- 28 people completed follow-up survey

Committee members profile

- Primarily people with experience in affordable housing, city planning, and local neighborhood politics
- Majority of people are not currently engaged with LFNC
- All have expressed intent to volunteer their time to learn more about housing and to make Los Feliz a better place live into the future
