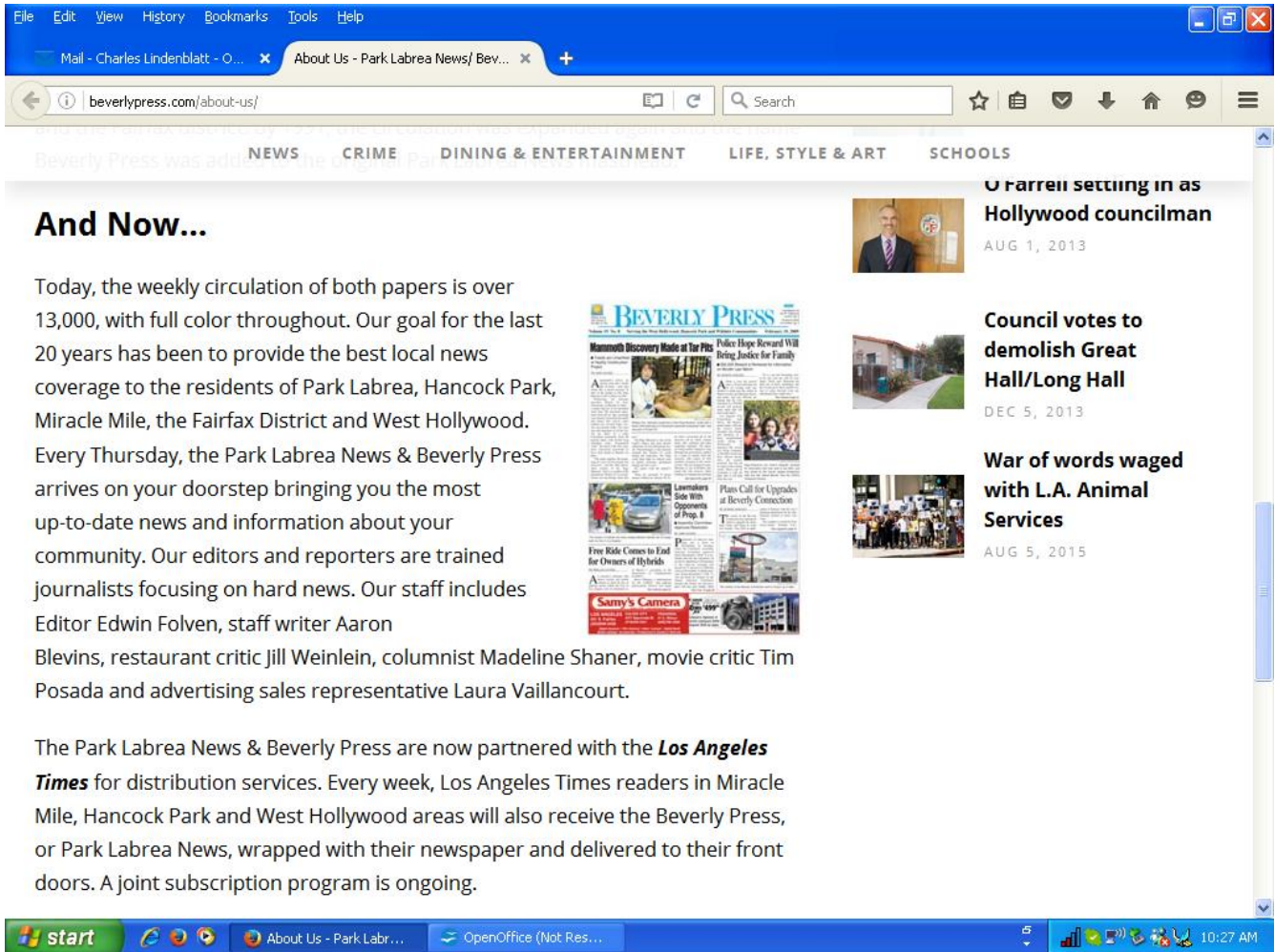


Charles Lindenblatt – Election Challenge Documentation File #1 of 2

The distribution of ads and slates within the Mid City West area during the period leading up to the election, I believe, could easily have generated a minimum of 18 voters (out of 328 total) who wanted to vote for fewer than the maximum number of candidates selected within each category, but voted for more, due to the problematic voter instructions, as the documentation below suggests:
