In the 1980s, I worked for a marketing research company in Los Angeles and it was then I knew something was wrong with the electorate process. During Ronald Reagan's campaign for re-election as president, I was tasked with surveying people via phone, to determine who they wanted to lead the country. The people I surveyed indicated they did not want Regan as president. Furthermore, the final results of the survey, reported Reagan at the bottom of the list of candidates. However, Reagan and Bush won the election by a landslide.

## **ELECTION REFORMS WITH TRANSPARENCY**

I propose that we change to a **Visual Instant Result Voting System** that would allow election results to be viewed and counted by multiple sources and produce rapid results for our elections. One model is for voters to come to a public location like a sports stadium to cast their votes. As the votes are casted, it is recorded via video. This will allow government officials as well as all citizens to see the results in real time with almost instantaneous results. The picture below at a Trump rally in a stadium during the last Republican convention in California is a good example.



## **EQUAL CAMPAIGN PROVISIONS & EXPOSURES**

The other factor is the quality of the candidates that are running for office. Our current election system is dependent almost entirely on who raises the most money within their campaign. This economic factor is another reason why there are the same old corrupt politicians in office for decades that most Americans do not vote for and why there is such a low voter turnout at all elections.

The solution to this problem is to have election campaigns that are subsidized by tax dollars and provisions for media adds on an equal basis for all candidates that are running for any office. This will empower the American citizens by the provision of a better selection of quality candidates that want to address the issues in our government

that will have results for the best interests of the American citizen not “big money” or special interests.

The Visual Voting System will require some research and development to establish its validity and reliability for this type of election process as well as financial resources for development. Conducting pilot tests are the best way to approach the study in the beginning stages. I believe that these results will prove to be very effective in a short period of time because it will give obvious and dependable results that can be verified by all interested parties and persons.

The network TV stations can facilitate this process of increasing exposure of quality candidates by producing a variety of media promotions for candidates at a low-cost or no cost to the candidate, similar to what public access stations nationwide have done. If legislation can be passed soon to receive tax breaks for TV stations to produce these low cost promotions for political candidates, the national TV stations would be more interested in participation. The legislation could also benefit independent radio and TV stations as well.

### **COMMENTS & CONCLUSION**

These reforms contained in this document will need further development. The cause of the corruption in our government and the solutions that I have presented in this document are very obvious and should be easy to understand. This is what the Black politicians and city officials should have been trying to do for many years. They have the positions and the power to correct this run away corruption that has victimized the American people for over 30 years. As Donald J. Trump, stated: “the system is totally rigged!”
